The IDAHO VICTORY FUND PAC is a federally registered joint fundraising committee comprised of the IDAHO REPUBLICAN PARTY (IRP), a political party committee and the IDAHO VICTORY FUND (IVF), an Idaho political committee (jointly “Committees”).

The IDAHO VICTORY FUND PAC may accept unlimited contributions from individuals, PACs and corporations; however, contributions from sources or in amounts prohibited by federal law and rule will be distributed only to those participants who can accept them. Contributions from individuals, PACs and corporations who have maxed out to the IRP will be reallocated to the IVF. Once the maximum allocation to the IRP has been achieved all contributions will be reallocated to the IVF. All impermissible contributions will be refunded.

Contributions to the Idaho Victory Fund PAC are not deductible as charitable contributions for Federal income tax purposes. Federal law requires the use of best efforts to report the name, address, occupation, and employer of individuals contributing \$200 or more per year. Non-exempt contributions to the IRP from individuals and non-multicandidate federal PACs are limited to \$10,000, per year. Non-exempt contributions from multicandidate federal PACs to the IRP are limited to \$5,000, per year. Federal contributions to the IRP will be used for Federal election purposes.
